

01 When do our Summer Schools take place?

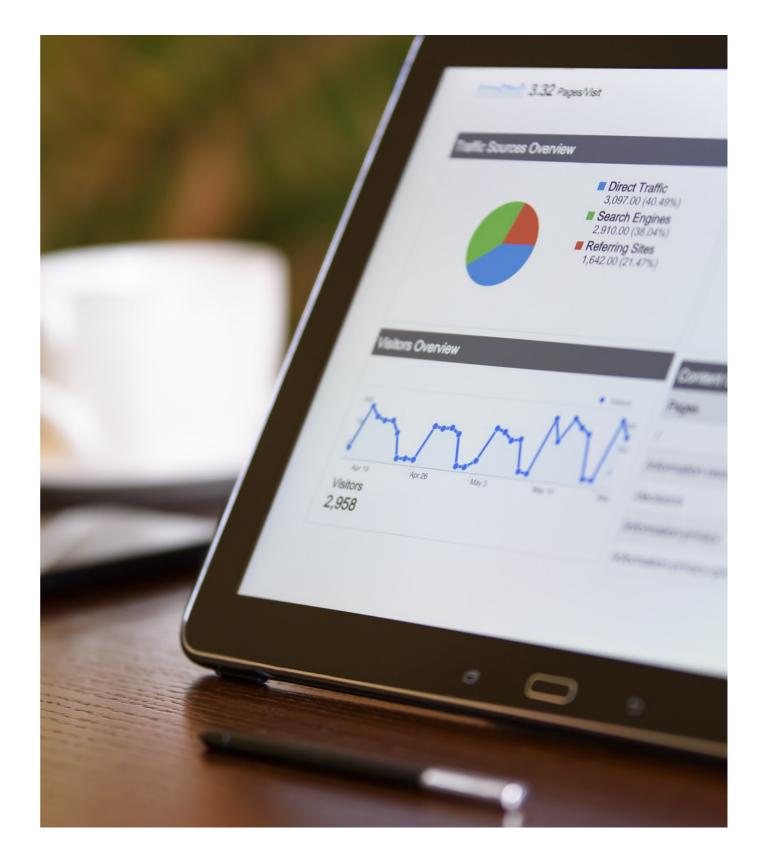
7 June - 31 July 2021

To receive the certificates of participation and the funds allocated, you need to spend one week with us = 50 hours = the equivalent of 2 ECTS.

Since we are aware 50 hours online is much more complicated to handle than live, we have split them over two months, for easier access.

50 hours between 7 June and 31 July 2021:

- 30 hours in live trainings with teachers and trainers
- 5 hours working on the final BLOCKS Game with your team mates (international groups are created at the beginning of the summer school)
- 15 hours at your own pace on the BLOCKS platform

3 Iterations to each live course

At the beginning of the summer school, you shall be assigned to an international Group.

Each Group has its own schedule, but if you missed a live training, you can always attend it with a different cohort.

Practically, you mix and match the live trainings according to your agenda.

6 modules for each Group:

- 1. Introduction 1 live training of 1 hour
- 2. Basics of blockchain BASICS
 - 6 live trainings of 2 hours each
- 3. Digital transformation DT
 - 3 live trainings of 1 hour each
- 4. Blockchain Industry UseCases USECASE
 - 12 live trainings of 1 hour each
- A Conversation on Trust and Trustless TRUST 1 live training of 2 hours
- 6. The BLOCKS Survival Game project SURVIVAL 5 hours with your group

3 hours per day

2-4 days per week

Section 02 Where do our Summer Schools take place?

ONLINE

Once you were selected to the Summer School, you should know there are two different venues to fulfil all requirements:

- On Zoom for 35 hours overall
 - You will meet live with teachers and trainers
 - Out of the 35 hours, you will have 5 hours allocated to work on your final BLOCKS Game with your team mates, under the supervision of a teacher / trainer
 - There are 3 iterations of each course, if you missed a course allocated to your cohort, you can always join the other cohorts
 - You need to check all courses to receive the certificate
 - The 3 iterations take place between 7 June and 31 July 2021.
 - Links to each course shall be posted in the Space dedicated to the Summer Schools on the BLOCKS Platform.
 - Attendance shall be recorded at each course.
- Online on the BLOCKS Platform for an extra 15 hours
 - Earn badges on the courses already uploaded on the platform
 - At your own pace until 15 August 2021.

* **Develop** a long-term Digital Transformation strategy and vision for a company based on blockchain use cases.

Assessment: Participants will be assessed based on the following:

- participation
- a team project involving an offline BLOCKS Game
- Badges earned prior and during the Summer School on the BLOCKS Platform.

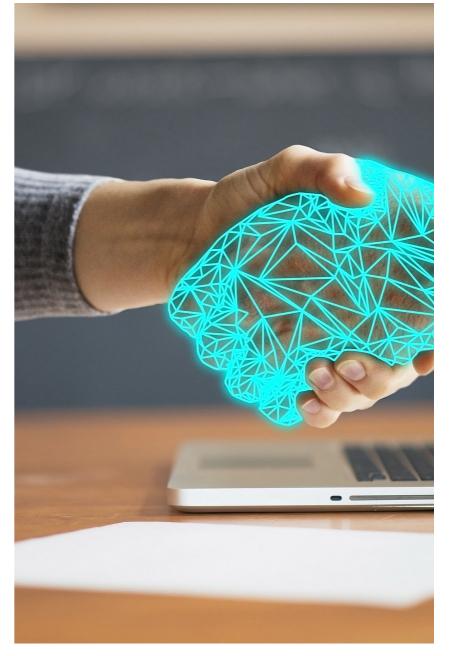
